

You do not have to write the code that goes inside the parentheses on the first line of each method.

1. Complete the method named `btnExit_Click` so that it causes a program to end.

```
Private Sub btnExit_Click()
```

End Sub

2. Complete the method named `btnClear_Click` that clears the labels `lblName` and `lblSchool`.

```
Private Sub btnClear_Click()
```

```
End Sub
```

3. Write a complete method that causes a message box with the phrase "Hello" to appear when someone clicks a button named `btnStart`. You must write the first line of the method (also known as the method header).

4. Write a method that causes whatever string is stored in a textbox named `txtInput` to show up in a label named `lblOutput` when a button named `btnDisplay` is clicked. You must write the method header.

5. Write a method that causes a message box with the phrase "Hello Saturn" to appear as soon as a program is executed (that is, as soon as `Form1` loads). You can assume that the form is named `Form1`.

Private Sub Form1_Load()
```
